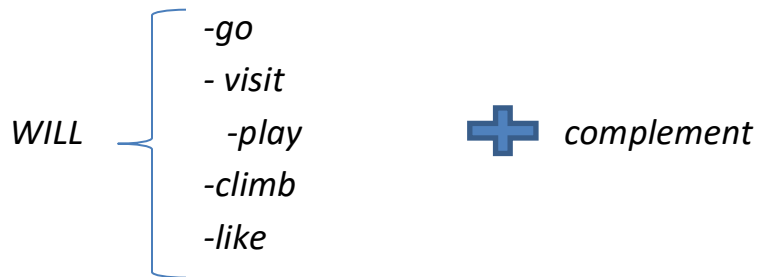


Good morning students ,how are you?

*Let's study the **Future simple***

*El verbo auxiliar **WILL** es usado para hablar acerca de futuros eventos ,o para predecir lo que ocurrirá en el futuro.*

Se usa Will seguido del verbo que indica la acción a ejecutarse en presente.



Examples: I will go to the theater on Saturday (affirmative form)

Auxiliar + verbo

I 'll go to the theater on Saturday (contraction form)

Auxiliar +verbo

I will not go to the theater on Saturday(negative form

Auxiliary +not+verbo

I won't go to the theater on Saturday (contraction form)

Auxiliar contractado +verbo

Estas son las 4 formas de usar el auxiliary will en las oraciones,de manera afirmativa y negative con sus respectivas contracciones que no es mas que abreviar el auxiliar will.

Ahora vamos a ver la otra forma de usar el futuro con la estructura :

GOING TO

Se usa el **GOING TO** para hablar acerca de un evento en futuro o describir una acción la cual se planea hacer en el futuro inmediato. La fórmula para esta estructura es con el verbo **TO BE** (Ser o Estar) en presente simple mas **going to** más el verbo que indica la acción a ejecutarse en presente simple.

TO BE (present) + GOING TO + Verbos en presente

I	AM		SPEAK
YOU			TRAVEL
WE		ARE GOING TO	 BUY
THEY			READ
SHE			DO
HE		IS GOING TO	 SEE
IT			EAT

Examples : I am going to speak English with my friends.

-You are going to travel to Merida this weekend.

-She is going to buy an apple

-We are going to read a story

-They are going to do some exercise

-He is going to eat a hamburger

Ambas estructuras van al inicio de la oración, es decir se colocan de primeras, veamos:

1-Will she buy a blouse? Yes, she will buy a blouse.

2-Will they play tennis on Sunday? Yes, they will play tennis on Sunday.

3-Will you come to my house soon? Yes, I will.

Ahora veamos en forma negativa

4-Will you visit your family this afternoon? No, I will not

No, I won't.

GOING TO → Are you going to study?

Auxiliar

To be + going to

1-Are you going to cook some cookies? Yes, I am going to cook some cookies.

2-Is she going to climb the mountain? Yes,she is going to climb the mountain

3-Are they going to eat fish later? Yes,they are going to eat fish later.
